

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2012 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

In 2012, strong growth in the first four months of the year help keep EWR passenger traffic in positive territory for the year, which returned growth of 0.9%. In the process, the airport handled 34 million passengers, 316,535 more than the previous year. Domestic traffic, which makes up 67 % of the airport's traffic, grew 2.9 % and was the main driver behind the growth. International traffic fell 2.9% due to a 1.7 % contraction of international seats capacity by UA/CO, and the absence of Air France and Lot Polish consolidating at JFK. Cargo remained weak, declining 8.7%.
