

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

JFK established two significant records in 2013. For the first time ever, passenger levels pierced the 50 million threshold as the airport handled 50.4 million passengers, up 2.3% over 2012. In addition, international passengers hit a record 26.5 million, exceeding last year's record level by 800,000 passengers, for a growth of 5.9%. Additional highlights include record passenger gains accomplished with a minimal increase in flights (because airplanes got larger). Domestic traffic was consistently weak all year. It closed out the year down 1.4%. Cargo rebounded partially as it ended the year down only 0.1% compared to a decline of 4.6% in 2012.
