

Aviation Department

Boosted by stronger-than-anticipated growth in the first four months of the year, ACY ended the year up 7%, and in doing so distinguished itself as the fastest growing among our facilities in 2014. In 2014, it increased seat capacity by 3.2% and handled 1.21 million passengers. Of the 11 markets served at ACY, traffic grew in seven markets and fell in four, particularly at Detroit, Atlanta and Chicago. Though the region's economic foundations were shaken with an incessant stream of casino-closure and United has ceased operations, efforts to attract new carriers have intensified in recent months. Based on the strength of outreach efforts, we remain hopeful that ACY can continue to grow in 2015.
