

Aviation Department

With 35.6 million passengers, EWR's 2014 traffic grew 1.7%. While EWR did not set an overall record in 2014, it did set a new international passenger record by handling 11.8 million passengers, 2.9% higher than the previous record set in 2011. Overall, it ended the year handling 35.6 million passengers, only 800,000 shy of the 36.4 million peak it established in 2007. Domestic traffic grew only 0.2%. EWR's cargo grew 0.5% in 2014. While the level appears unenthusiastically flat, it was nevertheless a welcome change when viewed in the context of its perennial negative annual performance since 2010.
