

Aviation Department

JFK established two significant records in 2014. For the first time ever, the airport handled 53.3 million passengers, up 5.6%, representing 2.8 million more passengers than 2013. In addition, international passengers hit a record 28.2 million, exceeding last year's record level by 1.7 million passengers. Following a 1.4% decline last year, domestic passenger traffic rebounded by serving 25 million passengers, a 4.6% increase. In 2014, cargo finally pierced the positive curtain with a gain of 1.7%. In doing so, it helped to lift the region's cargo to positive territory.
