

Aviation Department

After weather-related struggles in the beginning of the year, LGA ended the year up 1%, and in doing so broke multiple records. It handled 26.9 million passengers, the highest ever, eclipsing the old record of 26.7 million passengers set last year by 230,000 passengers.

Among its other 2014 highlights, LaGuardia broke the previous domestic passenger record of 24.5 million, also set last year, by handling 25.1 million passengers. It also set a new international passenger record by handling 1.8 million passengers, about 87,000 higher than the previous record. International traffic led the growth with a gain of 5.1% and domestic was up 0.7%.
