Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger growth slows some to about 6%, inline with the industry. Transcontinental markets took the biggest hit, having been a low cost battle ground for much of the year. Freight is up 6.7% reflecting recent corrections for Continental and Lufthansa.
