The airport handled 2.8 million passengers ' a record February. EWR's 13.4 percent traffic growth - its highest growth rate since the 13.8 percent increase achieved in April 2006 - was led by the international sector, which grew 14.2 percent. United carried 103,068 additional passengers. International seat capacity improved by 8 percent - led by United and SAS Scandinavian Airlines. Domestic passenger traffic, too, posted a double-digit increase, up 13.1 percent, led by United with a gain of 109,830 passengers. Airlines increased domestic capacity by 165,644 seats, or 7.4 percent. Freight activity at EWR fell 3.5 percent. Domestic cargo, which constitutes over 60 percent of the airport's total, continued to lead the retrenchment with a 5 percent drop. International cargo edged slightly lower, down 1.1 percent.
