

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2019 TRAFFIC REPORT

EWR handled a record 3.352 million passengers (+95,214 travelers/+2.9 percent). EWR's domestic sector saw a record 2.288 million travelers (+50,817 passengers/+2.3 percent), even as carriers cut their domestic seat capacity by 86,144 seats (-2.8 percent). International passenger volume reached a record 1.064 million travelers (+44,397 passengers/+4.4 percent). EWR's total cargo activity posted its third consecutive monthly drop (-906 tons/-1.4 percent) as both domestic and international freight traffic fell. International cargo (which accounts for about 36 percent of EWR's total cargo) led the fall with a 2.7 percent drop (-618 tons). Domestic cargo fell by a modest 0.7 percent (-288 tons).
