

Aviation Department

Newark was the only airport that remained consistent with its solid performance in the first half of 2016 as it led our region's airports with a 4.1 percent gain and handled a record 3.7 million passengers - up 147,533 travelers. Continuing with a trend that began in March, the domestic sector led EWR's passenger growth with a 4.2 percent increase. Domestic seat capacity grew by 4.3 percent, or 118,006 seats. International seats expanded by 4.6 percent - up 67,014 seats. Following four months of solid growth, EWR showed modestly lower freight performance as both domestic and international cargo registered slight decreases. International cargo, which constitutes approximately 40 percent of the airport's total freight activity, led the fall with a 1.4 percent reduction - down 298 tons. Domestic cargo edged down 0.4 percent, losing 155 tons.
