

Aviation Department

EWR's total passenger traffic reached a record 3.936 million travelers (+211,641 passengers/+5.7 percent). The domestic sector bounced back from February's 0.5 percent dip and reached a record 2.779 passengers (+141,688 travelers/+5.4 percent). International passenger grew by 6.4 percent (+69,953 travelers) to a record 1.156 million passengers. International seats grew by 81,374 seats (+7.1 percent—the highest percentage among our airports). EWR's total freight volume posted its fifth consecutive monthly drop (-706 tons/-1 percent). Domestic cargo fell by 1.8 percent (-808 tons), mainly due to ABX Air, which ceased operations at EWR (in March 2018 ABX Air carried 1,457 tons). Mountain Air Cargo and UPS jointly handled 450 fewer tons. United and FedEx together added 1,129 tons. EWR was the only facility to grow international cargo (+0.40 percent/+102 tons).
