

Aviation Department

The airport handled 3.3 million passengers - a record for the month of March. EWR's 8.8 percent traffic growth - the highest growth rate of all our airports - was led by the domestic sector with a 9.5 percent increase. United carried 190,448 additional passengers. Airlines increased domestic capacity by 3.3 percent, or 85,744 seats. International passenger traffic was up 7.4 percent and was led by United's increased traffic of 76,783 passengers. International seat capacity improved by 1.3 percent - led by Air Canada and SAS Scandinavian Airlines. Freight activity at EWR improved by 5.6 percent. Growth was led by a 14.8 percent jump in domestic cargo, which constitutes over 60 percent of the airport's total cargo traffic. On the other hand, international cargo fell 7.6 percent.
