

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2018 TRAFFIC REPORT

EWR's total passenger volume surged by 7.4 percent (+250,276 travelers - the highest volume gain among our facilities) as it handled a record 3.637 million travelers. The domestic sector led growth with 128,332 added passengers (+5.5 percent to a record 2.462 million travelers. Domestic seat capacity grew by 5.1 percent (+150,772 seats), resulting in higher load factors. The international sector grew at a double digit pace of 11.6 percent (+121,944 passengers) and reached a new mark of 1.176 million passengers. Carriers grew their international seats by 8.1 percent (+107,520 seats - highest level increase among our airports). EWR's total freight traffic inched up 0.02 percent (+12 tons). Growth was totally driven by the international sector's 855 added tons (+3.6 percent) as domestic cargo fell (-1.9 percent/-843 tons).
