

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2009 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined (8.1%) on (7.0%) fewer seats. Domestic traffic fell (6.5%) on (7.8%) fewer seats, while International traffic declined by (10.1%). Freight declined (35.2%) mirroring January's decline. This was split between (30.0%) domestic and (36.5%) international losses. Freighter flights were down (39.3%).
