

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2011 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic increased 3.8 percent and seat capacity increased by a nearly identical amount. More important, domestic traffic, which had been weakened by the recession and had been lagging international growth, is on the cusp of strong rebound. At 5.8 percent, the domestic growth rate was more than three times the rate of international growth (1.6 percent). Excluding last November's data (which was distorted by the influence of Thanksgiving travel), this is the first time since September 2007 that monthly domestic growth has exceeded international. Cargo was up 6.9%.
