

Aviation Department

With growth of 6.4 percent and a capacity gain of 7.5 percent, LaGuardia led our region again, continuing a trend begun in October 2009. Traffic growth was balanced as domestic and international grew 6.3 and 7.1 percent respectively. This put the February domestic passenger level at 1.4 million passengers, making it the 12th consecutive month in which LGA's monthly passenger levels have exceeded EWR's.
