Aviation Department

Passenger traffic rose 3.5 percent on 3.3 percent more seats. February 2011 marked the inaugural operations of charter services at SWF. The weekly charter service to Cancun was managed by Apple Vacations tour operator, using Allegiant's B575 aircraft and crews. The inaugural charter contributed 503 international passengers and may lay the groundwork for Allegiant to reconsider a return to Stewart for its own scheduled operations.
