

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at EWR fell 2.8% in February. International dropped 6% compared to 1.3% decline for domestic passengers traffic. The decline dragged YTD February traffic down to 0.6%. Among the top five domestic carriers, only U.S. Airways and Southwest gained traffic in February. The traffic decline was attributable directly to massive cancellations of connecting flights by United/Continental that cancelled 1492 flights. The fact that 2012 was a leap year also meant one less day of activity in February of this year. Following the pattern established throughout last year, cargo volumes continued its disappointing trend falling 10% in February. We are in the process of revising the cargo forecast downward.
