

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

February traffic fell 1.8%, with domestic falling 4.9% while international maintained a gain of 1.7%. As a result of winter storm Nemo, Jetblue, the top ranked domestic carrier, cancelled 263 flights, American cancelled 157, Delta cancelled comparable amounts and Virgin America cancelled 27 flights. Collectively, these airlines carried 120,000 fewer passengers compared to the same time last year. Nevertheless, YTD February growth remained at high 2.9% due to the record January increase. Again, the disappointment is in the cargo sector where it fell 4.9%. Though domestic cargo gained 1.3%, it only accounted for less than 20% of the airport's cargo.
