

With 4,156 cancelled flights due to multiple snowstorms, EWR's monthly passenger traffic dipped 2.4%, with domestic down 2.8% and international falling 1.4%. United, US Airways, Alaska Airlines and JetBlue collectively carried 83,500 fewer passengers on their domestic destinations. Similar to domestic, international passenger traffic fell. Although transatlantic traffic, which makes up more than half of international travel, was up 2.6% along with strong travel to Mexico, the sharp decrease of passenger flow to and from Canada, Latin America and transpacific markets pulled down the overall international segment. Cargo tonnage declined 8.9%. The domestic segment led losses with a 14% reduction, and international was down 0.3%.
