

Aviation Department

Despite severe weather, JFK experienced the fewest cancellations among our airports in February. Although domestic was down 2.5%, overall JFK traffic was up 1.7% due to robust growth of 6% in international passenger traffic. Moreover, this month became the best February ever for international traffic, exceeding 1.6 million for the first time. Also for the first time since 2002, international traffic exceeded domestic traffic in February. Delta, JetBlue, Emirates, Norwegian and Aerolineas Argentina combined carried 95,700 more passengers on a combined 20.3% seat capacity increase. The top five international destinations with incremental seat capacity exceeding 4,000 were Milan, Buenos Aires, Frankfurt, Mexico City and Oslo. On the domestic routes, American, JetBlue, Virgin America and Hawaiian combined carried 69,000 fewer passengers, weighing heaviest on the domestic market decline. Cargo contracted 2.4% in February with international, which still is considered an engine of growth for 2014, experienced a sudden drop of 1.1% and domestic fell by 8.2%.
