LGA experienced the most cancellations during this wintery February, exceeding 4,200 in all. Domestic passenger traffic, which makes up 95% of the airport's overall capacity, fell a hefty 6.1%. Although international was up 7.9%, its small share could not lift total traffic, which decreased 5.3%. Seven out of nine carriers serving domestic destinations combined to carry 113,000 fewer passengers in February, with US Airways and Delta accounting for 49,000 and 37,600 respectively. American Eagle, Air Canada, Delta and Westjet performed well, especially Delta, which increased its seat capacity by 31%. Among destinations, Bermuda and Aruba were the biggest beneficiaries. Following a record number of flight cancellations due to multiple snowstorms, freight declined 11.9%.
