

Aviation Department

ACY's passenger traffic increased 6.8% following a 9.4% seat capacity expansion by Spirit Airlines in February, the only regular airline at the airport after United's departure in December last year. Spirit served six domestic destinations-all of them in Florida. The incremental capacity increase was solely allocated to Orlando, which saw a 50% increase. Short-term prospects remain positive for ACY as Air Canada is scheduled to begin services to Toronto in summer.
