

Regional passenger traffic rose 4.9% led by Newark Liberty with an 11.3% gain. Movements kept in step with a 4.1% increase, spurred by a 4.8% jump in domestic flights. Freight declined (5.4%). American Transport Association member airlines experienced a passenger gain of 0.4% and a 2.3% increase in ton-miles.
