

Aviation Department

LaGuardia passenger traffic fell (13.8%), with declines to domestic and international markets of (13.2%) and (23.6%) respectively. Mainline operations fell by (11.2%) and commuter/regional jet flights fell by (9.7%). No airlines at LGA had any growth this month—unless you count the combined 359 passengers added by Airtran, Spirit and Miami Air.
