

Aviation Department

Traffic fell (64.8%) on a (60.7%) decrease in domestic seats, raising load factors about 3 percentage points. Note the new passenger demographics section on page 2 of Stewart's January report, reflecting survey work done in May and June of 2008. Freight is down (47.5%), reflecting the winding down of the DHL/ABX service.
