Total seat capacity in January increased 3.6% and passenger traffic grew 5.8% as the airport set a new January record of 3.7 million passengers. International traffic also grew 8.1% and set new January record of 1.89 million. Domestic traffic was up 3.5%. International growth was led by Delta and JetBlue which collectively added a net of nearly 50,000 passengers. Aeroflot and Air Berlin supported international growth with an additional 26,000 through extended seasonal services. JFK was a big beneficiary of the timing of the Chinese New Year as cargo volume from the Asian Pacific grew 1.6%. As a result, January traffic was down by only 1.4%. Cargo traffic would have fallen by a bigger amount without the Chinese New Year bounce.
