

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

SWF continues to experience passenger attrition, as passenger traffic fell nearly 16%. Contributing factors include Delta, whose passenger activity dropped 44.3% because it completely eliminated service to Atlanta. The termination of the Atlanta service translated to a loss of 3,766 monthly departing seats. Additionally, USAirways reduced its seat capacity to Philadelphia by 17%. The only good news at SWF is Jetblue, the number one ranking carrier at the airport increased its seat capacity to Orlando by 4.6%. As a result its passenger level in January grew 2.1%.
