Because of multiple heavy snowstorms during the month, airlines had to cancel or delay many flights at EWR. This lowered passenger traffic by 1.1%, with domestic growing just 0.6% following a 2.9% seat capacity increase and international declining a hefty 4.4% after a 1.8% decline in seats. Although United, JetBlue, Delta and Alaska Airlines collectively carried 36,200 fewer passengers on their domestic routes, Virgin America, US Airways and Southwest combined served 45,300 more, contributing to the airport's domestic increase. In contrast, international traffic contracted because of United's 5.9% seat capacity decrease. The cargo sector declined 10.9% with international freight down 5.6% and domestic dropping 13.5%.
