

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2014 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Despite the unfavorable weather conditions, passenger traffic at SWF grew 1.5% because of Allegiant Air's arrival with a flight to Tampa. US Airways increased its passenger flow to Philadelphia by 5.1%. However, JetBlue, the airport's dominant carrier, decreased its passenger traffic by 16% because of seat capacity reduction to Orlando and bad weather. Delta, with a single destination to Detroit, increased seat capacity by 3%, but fell 7.2% short on passenger traffic.
