

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic decreased 1% in January. Even though international travel rose 1.3%, domestic decreased 2.2%, and with 65% of airport traffic stateside, it pulled EWR's January travel down. US Airways significantly decreased its capacity in domestic routes, cutting 14.6% of seats, which led to 17,400 fewer passengers. United cut its domestic capacity by 1%. Because of United's dominance, the 1% capacity reduction translated to a much larger passenger decline of 61,700 fewer travelers. In contrast, international seat capacity expanded 3.4%, leading to a 1.3% uptick in traffic. Cathay, JetBlue, American, Delta and Austrian combined carried 37,400 more passengers. The cargo sector showed the strongest performance with an 8% increase both for domestic and international tonnage. The growth was the largest among our airports, accounting for 82% of the region's increase.
