

Aviation Department

Even though seat capacity expanded 3.3% at LGA, passenger traffic decreased 1.6% with domestic declining 1.1% and international contracting a hefty 8.4%. International travel experienced a steep decline because Delta cancelled its flights to Nassau and Bermuda, and American cut its seat capacity to Toronto by 34%. On their domestic destinations, airlines offered 4.5% more capacity but carried fewer passengers. Even though JetBlue, Southwest, our new entrant Virgin America, Frontier and United combined carried 63,000 more passengers, US Airways, American, and Delta combined carried 82,800 fewer passengers, with American and US Airways accounting for 67% of this decline.
