

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

The airport handled 2.7 million passengers - the highest number for January. EWR led our airports with the highest number of flight cancellation due to Winter Storm Jonas - nearly 2,700 flights. EWR's 3.2 percent traffic growth was led by the domestic sector, which grew 4 percent. United carried 14,480 additional passengers. Airlines increased domestic capacity by 65,426 seats, or 2.7 percent. United added 73,996 seats - up 4.5 percent. In contrast to the negative performance that characterized most of 2015, international passenger traffic increased 1.3 percent, led by United with a gain of 29,475 passengers. International seat capacity improved by 3.3 percent - or 39,676 additional seats. Freight activity fell 2 percent. Domestic cargo led the retrenchment with a 2.3 percent drop. International cargo fell 1.3 percent.
