

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JANUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at JFK rose 7 percent, and set a record for the month of January - 4.2 million passengers - even with the cancellation of more than 1,700 flights due to Winter Storm Jonas. The international sector led the growth with an 8.1 percent increase. JetBlue, Delta, and Emirates were the top contributors of JFK's international passenger increase, accounting for a combined 77,760 additional passengers. Led by Delta and JetBlue, the domestic sector grew 5.8 percent. Carriers expanded domestic capacity by 3.4 percent, led by Delta and JetBlue. Airlines expanded international seat capacity by 9.5 percent - a total of 280,658 additional seats. JFK's cargo traffic fell 1.4 percent in January. The domestic sector led the fall with a 3.2 percent drop. International cargo activity fell 1 percent.
