The cancellation of more than 2,000 flights due to Winter Storm Jonas did not prevent LGA from leading the region's growth in January, as total passenger traffic jumped 10.3 percent and reached a record 2 million passengers. This increase was driven by an 11.7 percent climb in domestic traffic and was led by Delta and Southwest. Combined, these two carriers transported 76,311 additional domestic passengers, while decreasing seat capacity 0.9 percent and 1.7 percent respectively. Overall, domestic seat capacity fell 1.2 percent - which translates to higher aircraft load factors. International traffic was down 12.5 percent, despite a 3.6 percent increase in seat capacity, and was led by Air Canada and American. LGA's cargo activity was down 11.9 percent.
