Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's passenger traffic began the year at a strong pace, growing 6.5 percent and reaching the highest number of passengers for the month of January in spite of the adverse impact of Winter Storm Jonas which caused the cancellation of more than 6,400 flights. Our airports served a record 9.067 million passengers, or 551,190 more than we handled in January 2015. Domestic traffic set the pace with a 7 percent increase and set a new record level for the month of January. International traffic, too, set a new monthly mark and grew 5.5 percent. The region's traffic growth benefitted from a 3.7 percent seat capacity expansion. Following a modest increase in December, the region's cargo performance began the year in negative territory as it decreased 1.6 percent. Domestic cargo led the fall with a 2.5 percent decrease and international freight fell 1.1 percent.
