

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Passenger traffic at JFK rose 9.9 percent, and set a record for the month of February with 3.9 million passengers. The international sector led growth with a 12.2 percent increase. JetBlue and Delta were the top contributors to JFK's international passenger increase, handling a combined 78,733 additional passengers. The domestic sector grew 7.8 percent. JetBlue and Delta continued to be the top contributors to JFK's domestic passenger gain, handling a combined 125,629 additional passengers. Carriers expanded domestic capacity by 8.7 percent. Airlines expanded international seat capacity by 13.4 percent. JFK's cargo activity fell 4.2 percent in February. The international sector led the fall with a 4.3 percent drop. Domestic cargo, which accounts for 18 percent of JFK's cargo activity, fell 3.4 percent.
