

JFK's passenger traffic gained a record 5.3 million passengers - up 164,436 passengers and a 3.2 percent increase. The international sector led the region's growth with a 4.7 percent increase (a record 2.9 million passengers). JFK's international seat capacity grew 6.6 percent - the highest among our airports. Seats growth was led, in order, by American, Delta, and JetBlue. The domestic sector, too, achieved a new monthly record - 2.4 million passengers - while growing at a comparatively modest pace of 1.4 percent. Airlines expanded domestic seats by 2.8 percent. JFK's cargo traffic declined 7.2 percent. This drop was driven by a 10.2 percent plummet in international cargo activity - which accounts for approximately 80 percent of JFK's total cargo traffic. Domestic cargo grew 7.7 percent.
