

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at JFK rose 7.4 percent, and set a record for March with 4.7 million passengers. The international sector led the growth with an 8.3 percent increase. JetBlue and Delta were the top contributors to JFK's international passenger increase, handling a combined 75,217 additional passengers. The domestic sector grew 6.5 percent. Delta, JetBlue and American were the top contributors to JFK's domestic passenger gain, handling a combined 226,073 additional passengers. Carriers expanded domestic seat capacity by 4.3 percent. Airlines expanded international seats by 9 percent. JFK's cargo activity fell 6.7 percent in March. The international sector, which accounts for 82 percent of JFK's cargo traffic, led the fall with a 9.2 percent drop. Domestic cargo decreased 6.2 percent.
