

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic declined 2.5 percent on a 2.3 percent seat reduction. Typical of the pattern, domestic traffic trailed international with a 7.5 percent loss to 7.7 percent gain – on 5.5 percent fewer domestic and 4.3 percent more international seats. By world region, transpacific traffic led growth with a 19 percent passenger gain, followed by an 8 percent gain for Latin America. At Newark, freight increased 13.5 percent overall, with international freight growing 38.8 percent against a weak July 2009, while domestic freight increased 3.7 percent.
