

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic increased 1.7 percent in July, half of its June rate, on 1.3 percent fewer seats. A 5.3 percent domestic passenger loss on 8.7 percent fewer seats was more than offset by a 9 percent international gain on 6.4 percent more seats. Caribbean, Central and South American markets each rose by about 12 percent. Transpacific traffic grew 5.9 percent, on a 1.2 percent seat growth, raising the load factor by about 4 points. The transatlantic market grew 7.7 percent on 4 percent more seats. JFK freight gained 24.3 percent, split 5.2 percent for domestic to 29.6 percent for international.
