LaGuardia again led the region with 2.7 percent growth on a 0.7 percent increase in seat capacity. Traffic growth relative to 2009 slowed this month, a pattern seen in ACI data and in both passenger and freight market segments. Domestic traffic gained 2.7 percent, balanced by a 3 percent international increase. Legal issues surrounding the pending Delta – USAirways slot swap are warming up again as Delta appears concerned about DOT's award of 18 gates at Newark Liberty to Southwest, resulting from the United-Continental merger.
