

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic grew 13.9 percent in July, benefitting from a Jet Blue added daily nonstop to Orlando, and a Delta affiliate nonstop to Atlanta. Delta traffic increased 22.2 percent and JetBlue traffic gained 19.8 percent more passengers. The third passenger airline at Stewart, US Airways experienced a 9.7 percent decline in its Philadelphia traffic on a slight increase in capacity. Stewart's cargo operations remain on track, with a 33.6 percent gain on 42.2 percent more freighter operations. FedEx traffic was up 40.9 percent, with UPS up 17.2 percent.
