

## Aviation Department

ACY posted a 5.5% passenger traffic increase on a 7.7% seat capacity expansion this month. Even though Spirit Airlines expanded capacity only to Fort Lauderdale and kept other destinations flat, the carrier's actual traffic was up 2.6% due to increased travel to Atlanta, Boston, Myrtle Beach and Orlando. Of 6,035 incremental passengers at ACY this month, United accounted for 3,616 with services to Houston and Chicago. We expect casino closures and their related job and income loss to have a negative impact on charters in November/December traffic. However, the airport should still finish the year with growth in excess of 5%.
