

## Aviation Department

Even though domestic traffic remained flat in July, combined traffic at EWR increased 2% and it was a sole function of international travel, which expanded by 6% and finally pushed the YTD back to growth trajectory. Cathay Pacific, United, British, Austrian, JetBlue, TACA International, Porter Airlines and IcelandAir together carried 77,400 more passengers with Cathay and United combined accounting for 44%. Even though YTD cargo is down 4.3%, nevertheless it was a good month with domestic and international growing 13.2 and 13.6% respectively.
