

## Aviation Department

Regional passenger traffic declined (2.8%) on a 1.5% increase in seats. International led domestic with an 2.5% gain on 4.7% more seats to a (5.2%) domestic loss on 0.1% more seats. American Transport Association (ATA) member airlines reported a (3.9%) passenger loss, with a 4.0% international gain offsetting some of the (5.0%) domestic decline. Regional freight declined (11.1%) compared to an ATA carrier average gain of (2.9%) (the latter including mail).
