

Traffic fell 52.1% in June. The unflattering comparison to June 2008 is due to AirTran, which ceased service September 2008. Excluding AirTran, June traffic was down 28.4% compared with last year due to the lack of JetBlue's service to West Palm Beach that also ended last September. Freight was down 43.6% reflecting the loss of ABX/DHL operations, leaving FedEx and UPS as the sole operators there.
