EWR's June passenger traffic is up 1.9%, but YTD June traffic is flat as seat capacity fell 3.6%. YTD cargo is also up 14.5%. Consistent with the region's growth pattern, international traffic continued to lead the recovery with YTD June growth of 7%. Continental, the airport's dominant carrier increased international seat capacity by 2%, and carried nearly 200K more passengers. The domestic market remained weak. It shrunk 6%, carried 355K fewer passengers as growth declined 3.2%.
