

Aviation Department

LGA's June traffic grew 10.6%, bringing YTD June traffic growth to 10.2% on 1.5% seat gain. In contrast to JFK and EWR, LGA's traffic growth has been led consistently by the domestic sector since 3Q:2009 as domestic traffic grew 10.7% in the first half of 2010. LGA was also the only facility to experience an increase in domestic seat capacity, led by Delta and Southwest who collectively provided net passenger gains in excess of 500K. YTD International traffic is down 0.4%.
