

## Aviation Department

SWF's YTD June traffic is down 0.1% in spite of a 6.8% increase in seat capacity to Orlando and Atlanta by jetBlue and Delta respectively. Apple Tours, which suspended its charter operation as scheduled in May, is anticipated to resume charter activities during the winter. Advance data for July hints at significant gains in domestic traffic as a result of a successful jetBlue campaign to Florida markets.
